ACADEMIC CEREMONY

Academic Dress

The origin of academic dress can be traced to the medieval university, when robes were often necessary for warmth in the unheated halls where scholarly enclaves gathered. Today, the scholar's sweeping black gown has become a ceremonial symbol of academic distinction.

In the United States, formal guidelines for academic dress—known as the Intercollegiate Code—were initiated in 1895 and, following revision in 1932 and 1959, still provide the descriptive guidelines for interpreting ceremonial dress at an academic convocation. By stipulating design and color variations in the ceremonial robe, the Code provides a system to distinguish the academic degree, institution and field of study of the wearer.

Degree

The shape and size of the hood and the design of the sleeves indicate the academic degree of the wearer.

Bachelor's Degree: Pointed sleeves; usually

without hood

Master's Degree: Long, closed sleeves with arm

slits; narrow hood

Doctorate: Bell-shaped sleeves; broad, draped hood

Field of Study

The color of the hood facing identifies the field of study in which the academic degree was conferred.

Drab: Accounting, Business, Management

White: Arts, Letters, Humanities

Copper: Economics **Light Blue**: Education **Brown**: Fine Arts

Lemon: Library Science

Pink: Music

Dark Blue: Philosophy

Sage Green: Physical Education

Golden Yellow: Science Cream: Social Studies Scarlet: Theology

Institution

The color of the lining of the hood denotes the college or university by which the degree was conferred. Examples of degree-granting institutions include:

Muhlenberg: cardinal and grey Johns Hopkins: gold and black Lehigh: brown and white

Penn: red and blue **Temple**: cherry and white

Yale: Yale blue

The Mace

The tradition of the mace in the academic ceremony is the result of a long evolution, from a short wooden club used in medieval hand-to-hand combat to a symbol of office carried by sergeant-at-arms in royal courts. Today, the mace serves as a symbol of college and university sovereignty. At Muhlenberg it is carried by the Marshal of the Faculty, who, as a function of her office, precedes the College President and Provost in academic procession.

The mace used in today's ceremony was presented to the College in 1966 as a gift of the Allentown Alumni Club and was designed by Allentown silversmith C. Leslie Smith. The center of the mace is a natural grain oak handle. At the top is the Luther Rose, placed there to show the debt the College owes to the Lutheran Church in America. The spurs or spikes are transformed from lethal features to an upward-facing coronet. Four major sets of symbols complete the head of the mace. One plate displays the Seal of the College, the Seal of the Muhlenberg family and a replica of the cross of the College Chapel. Another plate bears dates and places of importance in College history. A third plate features the lamp of knowledge, symbols of the Trinity, again relating the College to the Church, and other symbols representing commerce, medicine, law and the fine arts. The bottom of the mace is finished with an acorn and two oak leaves in silver, which represent the growth and strength of the College. The mace is used at all formal College functions.

CANDIDATES FOR HONORARY DEGREES



ANTHONY ABRAHAM JACK, PH.D.

Anthony Abraham Jack is an assistant professor of education at the Harvard Graduate School of Education, a sociologist and an author. Jack is a junior fellow at the Harvard Society of Fellows and holds the Shutzer Assistant Professorship at the Radcliffe Institute for Advanced Study.

Jack earned a dual bachelor's in women's and gender studies and religion from Amherst College and a master's and doctorate in sociology from Harvard University.

Jack's scholarship explores overlooked and underresearched issues in education. Of particular interest are systemic patterns of inequality related to urban poverty, race, culture and ethnicity.

His first book, *The Privileged Poor: How Elite Colleges Are Failing Poor Students* (2019), explores how traditionally underrepresented students are at a disadvantage at the nation's elite colleges and universities. The book also details strategies for these institutions to combat these inequities and help students excel.

The Privileged Poor received critical acclaim from National Review, NPR, The Boston Globe, The New York Times and other global media. For his work, Jack was named a recipient of the 2020 Mirra Komarovsky Book Award and the Thomas J. Wilson Memorial Prize. The book was named an NPR Best Book of 2019.

The New Yorker has said the "lasting beauty of his ethnography is that it gives a voice to the students who, as his research ends up revealing, most need it," and The Atlantic has praised The Privileged Poor, saying the work provides example after example of "the sort of social capital that many students, faculty, and administrators take for granted" and that Jack's work tells the story of "students who have done everything right are often the ones made to feel as if their place on campus is anything other than earned."

Jack frequently writes about his own experience as an underrepresented student at elite institutions of higher education. He has authored pieces published by *The Washington Post*, *The New York Times*, PBS, *Times Higher Education* and other national and global outlets.

His research has appeared in numerous professional journals, including *The Common Reader* and *Sociological Forum*. His publications have been featured in The *New York Times*, *The Atlantic*, *The New Yorker*, *The Chronicle of Higher Education*, *National Review*, *Financial Times*, *Times Higher Education* and more.

Jack is a member of a number of professional organizations, including the American Educational Research Association, the American Educational Studies Association, the American Sociological Association and the Association of Black Sociologists.



JANE THIERFELD BROWN P'10

Jane Thierfeld Brown is director of College Autism Spectrum, an organization that provides students with autism spectrum disorders and their families with college counseling and career preparation. She holds an appointment as an assistant clinical professor at Yale Child Study, Yale Medical School. Brown previously served as director of student services at the University of Connecticut School of Law.

Brown earned a bachelor's in speech pathology, master's degrees in education and counseling from the University of Rhode Island and a doctorate of education from Columbia University, Teachers College.

She has spent four decades in disability services, with a specific focus on children and young adults with autism. She is considered a leading expert on autism in higher education, including understanding how campus policies affect the behavior of students and how changes to campus structure can improve outcomes for college students on the autism spectrum.

Brown's work is more relevant than ever today; the government estimates 1 in 54 children have been identified with autism spectrum disorder. With an increasing number of spectrum students enrolling at colleges and universities

each year, Brown's advocacy and expertise have helped both families and institutions prepare for a successful college experience.

Brown is co-author of numerous books, including *The Parent's Guide to College for Students on the Autism Spectrum* (2012) and *Students with Asperger Syndrome: A Guide for College Professionals* (2009). Her writing has appeared in textbooks and peer-reviewed journals, including the *Journal of Autism and Developmental Disorders*, *New Directions for Student Services*, *Student Affairs Today*, *Campus Legal Advisor* and more.

Her frequent media appearances include segments on CBS News, *Good Morning America* and NPR. Brown has been quoted in *U.S. News & World Report* and *The New York Times*, and she has been interviewed by *Forbes*, NPR, *USA Today* and other national and global news outlets.

She is the parent of Hannah Brown, a 2010 graduate of Muhlenberg College.



BRIAN G. EKLUND '66

The Reverend Brian G. Eklund is an ordained Lutheran minister and the former director of New City Parish, a nonprofit coalition of Evangelical Lutheran Churches in the greater Los Angeles area.

Eklund earned his bachelor's in sociology from Muhlenberg College and his master's of divinity from the Lutheran School of Theology at Chicago.

While enrolled in seminary, Eklund was introduced to multicultural ministry, a calling that continued to be relevant throughout his career. As part of his education, he completed a year-long internship that combined methods of urban ministry, civil rights activism, intercultural understanding and theological practice.

Eklund served seven years at Mercy Hospital and Medical Center Mental Health Unit in San Diego, California, where care centered around the creation of a structured, therapeutic environment.

He returned to ministry as the pastor of St. Mark's Lutheran Church in Los Angeles for more than 30 years. His community-oriented, social-justice based approach to pastoral work helped that religious community embrace cultural and linguistic differences as the congregation grew more diverse over the years.

While at St. Mark's, Eklund coordinated efforts to promote community building and organizing, multilingual and multigenerational ministry and nonviolent civic action. In 1992, Eklund's congregation became one of the founding members of New City Parish.

Eklund's work has been described as "evidence of a long and dedicated life of spiritual service and influence" and "a shining example of the great good that can be accomplished by one dedicated and moral individual" by those who have witnessed his compassion, faith and commitment to community.

His advocacy and activism have been recognized at the local and international level by organizations as diverse as the Esperanza Community Housing Corporation; the city of Los Angeles; the California State Assembly and the California Governor's Office; and the city of Cuernavaca, Mexico.

Eklund is the husband of Ruth Hieter Eklund, Muhlenberg class of 1967.



JOHN M. HEFFER P'96

John M. Heffer is the former president of HSBC Business Credit (USA) Inc. He had previously served as president and chief operating officer at CIT Group/Factoring, president at Chatham Capital Corporation and executive vice president at AJ Armstrong Company.

Heffer earned a bachelor's in economics from the University of Pennsylvania. His support of higher education—particularly in the areas of faculty scholarship and academic support for undergraduates—have enhanced the experiences of generations of professors and those they teach.

Heffer is an active philanthropist whose support has benefited numerous organizations, including Muhlenberg College, the University of Pennsylvania, Chatham University and the Montefiore Medical Center.

John and his wife Barbara P'96 have provided consistent support for Jewish life at Muhlenberg College, including a leadership gift that saw an expansion of the Leffell Center for Jewish Student Life that began in 2010. In 2019, the Heffers were founding donors who pledged \$250,000 in support of the College's new Faculty Rising Scholars Program. The initiative provides junior faculty with a course

release and funding for research expenses, including Muhlenberg student research assistants. The Heffers had previously supported Muhlenberg through the development of the endowed Heffer Family Fund for Academic Support Services. They are members of the College's Chairman's Circle of the Henry Melchior Muhlenberg Society, The John Peter Gabriel Muhlenberg Circle of the Lifetime Giving Society and the Loyalty Society.

John served two terms on the Muhlenberg Board of Trustees—from 1994 to 2006 (acting as chair from 2002 to 2005) and again from 2007 to 2019. His board service included roles on campus life, nominations and governance, enrollment management and Wescoe (now known as the Muhlenberg College Division of Graduate and Continuing Education) committees; during his second board term, Heffer served as chair of the compensation committee. He served as a member of the College's Parents Council, and in 1998, Heffer was named the recipient of a Muhlenberg College Alumni Achievement Award for Service to the College by a Non-Alumnus.

Heffer is the parent of Alison Heffer, a 1996 graduate of Muhlenberg College, and of Douglas Heffer, a 2000 graduate of New York University.

MICHAEL JOSEPH BONADDIO '20

Michael Joseph Bonaddio graduated in May with a Bachelor of Arts in finance and business administration with a concentration in management.

Bonaddio served terms as

both president and vice president of the Cardinal Key Society, a student group that serves as ambassadors and assistants at many of the College's signature traditions and events. He also acted as a coordinator of Muhlenberg's campus delegate program, welcoming prospective students for extended visits to classes, meals and social activities at the College as well as volunteering at admissions' open house events.

During his final year at Muhlenberg, Bonaddio served as a member of the Senior Class Connections Campaign, working with alumni affairs to build relationships between the College and the Class of 2020.

His on-campus activities included time as a game management intern for Muhlenberg's athletic teams and as a manager to the College's men's lacrosse team. Bonaddio completed a recruitment internship for Sodexo, Muhlenberg's on-campus dining partner. NERFIS NIEVES '20

Nerfis Nieves of Allentown, Pennsylvania, graduated in May with a Bachelor of Arts in psychology, earned through the Muhlenberg College School of Continuing Studies.

Nieves is a member of Psi

Chi, the international honor society in psychology, and Alpha Sigma Lambda, an honors society that celebrates scholarship and leadership of adult students.

Nieves served as a member of the R.E.A.L. (Radical Education & Liberation) Collective, an on-campus organization that works alongside people who are currently and formerly incarcerated toward a goal of increasing access to higher education, reducing mass incarceration and building healthy communities.

Nieves credits the Inside Out Prison Exchange psychology course—modeled after the Inside Out Prison Exchange Program that brings together college students and incarcerated individuals in prisons and jails—as a defining moment of her Muhlenberg experience. In the course, Muhlenberg students and individuals who are incarcerated explore societal and structural issues related to crime, justice and injustice, with a goal of creating communities that are more humane, equitable and inclusive.

Nieves continued her advocacy work as a research assistant with the R.E.A.L. collective, under the mentorship of Kate Richmond, professor of psychology. Her responsibilities included working as an advisor to students enrolled in the College's Inside Out course as well as analyzing survey instruments to measure areas of impact for Inside Out programs.

During her time at Muhlenberg, Nieves completed an internship with Family Promise of the Lehigh Valley, a nonprofit organization that assists children and families experiencing homelessness.

At a future time, Nieves plans to continue her education through a master's program that focuses on education, social work or social justice advocacy. As a bilingual mother of two sons who completed her undergraduate degree as an adult learner, she believes she has a responsibility as a Latinx role model in her family and community.

HONORS

Degree recipients with outstanding scholastic records are graduated with academic honors. Those exceptional students with cumulative averages of 3.9 or higher (where A equals 4.0) are graduated summa cum laude. If the average is at least 3.7, but less than 3.9, the degree is granted magna cum laude. Those students with cumulative averages of at least 3.5, but less than 3.7, are graduated cum laude.


