Muhlenberg College is an independent, undergraduate, liberal arts institution located in Allentown, Pennsylvania, about fifty-five miles north of Philadelphia. With an undergraduate enrollment of approximately 2,200 students, Muhlenberg is dedicated to shaping creative, compassionate, collaborative citizens through rigorous academic programs in the arts, humanities, natural sciences and social sciences, as well as select preprofessional programs.

Founded in 1848 as Allentown Seminary, the institution was renamed Muhlenberg College in 1867 and began providing a liberal arts education committed to the highest standards of academic integrity and excellence.

Muhlenberg is unique among private colleges in offering programs in professional areas such as business, education, public health, media & communication and neuroscience in addition to the traditional liberal arts majors. The Muhlenberg curriculum provides opportunities for students in all programs to participate in research, community engagement, internships and study abroad options that provide critical experiences for students in today's rapidly changing world. The outstanding quality of the Muhlenberg academic program has been recognized by Phi Beta Kappa and some 15 additional national honorary societies with established chapters at the College.

The College is committed to providing students with powerful outcomes. The Career Center and The Muhlenberg Network of alumni and parents help students and graduates benefit from their rewarding learning experience through internship and job placement programs. Muhlenberg graduates are prepared to meet their personal definitions of success while continuing to value service to others in ways both big and small.

Honors

Degree recipients with outstanding scholastic records are graduated with academic honors. Those exceptional students with cumulative averages of 3.9 or higher (where A equals 4.0) are graduated summa cum laude. If the average is at least 3.7, but less than 3.9, the degree is granted magna cum laude. Those students with cumulative averages of at least 3.5, but less than 3.7, are graduated cum laude.

The designation of Latin Honors is contingent on a graduate's final grades, which were not available prior to the commencement exercises. Inclusion of honors in this program is an estimate based upon current GPA and should not be considered an official designation.





Academic Dress

The origin of academic dress can be traced to the medieval university, when robes were often necessary for warmth in the unheated halls where scholarly enclaves gathered. Today, the scholar's sweeping black gown has become a ceremonial symbol of academic distinction.

In the United States, formal guidelines for academic dress known as the Intercollegiate Code—were initiated in 1895 and, following revision in 1932 and 1959, still provide the descriptive guidelines for interpreting ceremonial dress at an academic convocation. By stipulating design and color variations in the ceremonial robe, the Code provides a system to distinguish the academic degree, institution and field of study of the wearer.

Degree

The shape and size of the hood and the design of the sleeves indicate the academic degree of the wearer.

Bachelor's Degree: Pointed sleeves; usually without hood
Master's Degree: Long, closed sleeves with arm slits; narrow hood
Doctorate: Bell-shaped sleeves; broad, draped hood

Field of Study

The color of the hood facing identifies the field of study in which the academic degree was conferred.

Drab: Accounting, Business, Management White: Arts, Letters, Humanities Copper: Economics Light Blue: Education Brown: Fine Arts Lemon: Library Science Pink: Music Dark Blue: Philosophy Sage Green: Physical Education Golden Yellow: Science Cream: Social Studies Scarlet: Theology

Institution

The color of the lining of the hood denotes the college or university by which the degree was conferred. Examples of degree-granting institutions include:

Muhlenberg: cardinal and grey Johns Hopkins: gold and black Lehigh: brown and white Penn: red and blue Temple: cherry and white Yale: Yale blue

The Mace

The tradition of the mace in the academic ceremony is the result of a long evolution, from a short wooden club used in medieval hand-to-hand combat to a symbol of office carried by sergeant-at-arms in royal courts. Today, the mace serves as a symbol of college and university sovereignty. At Muhlenberg it is carried by the Marshal of the Faculty, who, as a function of her office, precedes the College President and Provost in academic procession.

The mace used in today's ceremony was presented to the College in 1966 as a gift of the Allentown Alumni Club and was designed by Allentown silversmith C. Leslie Smith. The center of the mace is a natural grain oak handle. At the top is the Luther Rose, placed there to show the debt the College owes to the Lutheran Church in America. The spurs or spikes are transformed from lethal features to an upward-facing coronet. Four major sets of symbols complete the head of the mace. One plate displays the Seal of the College, the Seal of the Muhlenberg family and a replica of the cross of the College Chapel. Another plate bears dates and places of importance in College history. A third plate features the lamp of knowledge, symbols of the Trinity, again relating the College to the Church, and other symbols representing commerce, medicine, law and the fine arts. The bottom of the mace is finished with an acorn and two oak leaves in silver, which represent the growth and strength of the College. The mace is used at all formal College functions.

CANDIDATES FOR HONORARY DEGREES



EBOO PATEL, PH.D.

Eboo Patel is an internationally respected leader and frequent speaker on religious diversity, civic and community engagement, racial equity and interfaith work.

Born in Mumbai, India, Patel was raised as an Ismaili Muslim in Chicago. As a contrast to the bigotry he experienced as a youth, he found companionship and solace in the diverse community of his neighborhood. He became involved in social justice work during his undergraduate studies and learned that many of the leaders he respected most were inspired by their faith.

Patel is the founder and president of Interfaith Youth Core (IFYC), "a non-profit organization working to make interfaith cooperation a social norm in America." In the more than two decades since founding IFYC, the organization has partnered with educational institutions to work with students, faculty and staff at more than 600 colleges and universities.

Patel has authored four books and published dozens of articles and op-eds in publications such as The New York Times, National Public Radio, PBS NewsHour, the Washington Post and the Chronicle of Higher Education. His blog, "Conversations on Diversity," is a regular feature on InsideHigherEd.com. He served on President Barack Obama's Advisory Council on Faith-Based and Neighborhood Partnerships. Patel's work as a community leader and social entrepreneur has earned him recognition as an Ashoka Fellow, membership in the Young Global Leaders Network of the World Economic Forum and a role on the Religious Advisory Committee of the Council on Foreign Relations and the National Committee of the Aga Khan Foundation, which is dedicated to addressing the challenges of the world's poorest and most marginalized communities.

His work in leadership has earned him accolades from the Harvard Kennedy School Review and U.S. News & World Report, who have named him a Future Policy Leader and one of America's Best Leaders, respectively. He has been awarded the Louisville Grawemeyer Prize in Religion, the Guru Nanak Interfaith Prize, the El Hibri Peace Education Prize and the Council of Independent Colleges Academic Leadership Award, along with honorary degrees from more than 15 colleges.

Patel earned a bachelor's in sociology from the University of Illinois and a Ph.D. in the sociology of religion from Oxford University. He is a Rhodes scholar.



DR. KAREN H. ANTMAN '70

Dr. Karen Antman is an internationally recognized expert on breast cancer, mesotheliomas and sarcomas, and serves as provost of the medical campus and dean of Boston University School of Medicine.

Antman's previous appointments include deputy director for translational and clinical science at the National Cancer Institute of the National Institutes of Health and as the Wu Professor of Medicine and Pharmacology and Director of the Herbert Irving Comprehensive Cancer Center at Columbia University College of Physicians and Surgeons; during that appointment, she also co-directed the cancer care service line at New York Presbyterian Hospital. Antman served on the faculty of Harvard Medical School and had hospital appointments at Brigham and Women's Hospital and Dana-Farber Cancer Institute in Boston.

Through the publication of more than 300 articles and her work editing five textbooks, Antman has been a prolific contributor to the scientific literature of malignancies, sarcomas, cancer therapy, pharmacology and oncology. Antman has continued her service to her alma mater through membership on the College's Prehealth Alumni Advisory Committee. She is a member of Phi Beta Kappa, the National Academy of Medicine, the administration board of the American Association of Medical Colleges Council of Deans, the Journal of the American Medical Association Oversight Committee, the International Editorial Board of Lancet and the board of the Educational Commission for Foreign Medical Graduates. Her previous service includes roles as an associate editor of the New England Journal of Medicine and a position on the Council of the National Institutes of Health's Fogarty International Center.

Antman earned her bachelor's in chemistry from Muhlenberg College and her M.D. from Columbia University College of Physicians and Surgeons.



JEFFREY PAGE

Jeffrey Page is an Emmy Award-nominated director and choreographer, and he holds lecture posts at both Harvard University and The Juilliard School.

Page's work on Broadway includes a role in the cast of the original award-winning production of *Fela!* and as choreographer for the musical *Violet*. His international theatre experience includes the 2015 and 2018 productions of *Memphis* in Tokyo, Japan; the production received four Yomiuri Award nominations, including Best Musical.

Page has earned accolades in entertainment media and has been a featured choreographer on the hit television show *So You Think You Can Dance*. He has orchestrated choreography for some of the world's largest musical acts, including Beyoncé, the artist's "The Formation World Tour", a Coachella Valley Music and Arts Festival performance and two of her HBO specials. His work with singer Mariah Carey includes a role as associate creative director for Mariah Carey's "Sweet, Sweet Fantasy European Tour." Page's contributions as creative director and choreographer have earned critical acclaim, including an appointment as the first African American to serve as a Marcus Institute Fellow for Opera Directing at The Juilliard School, an MTV Video Music Award, a recipient of an Advisory Committee on Chorus Affairs' Outstanding Broadway Chorus for his performance in *Fela!* and recognition as one of the Top 100 African American Influencers by The Root.

In 2016, Page founded Movin' Legacy, an Indianapolisbased nonprofit organization dedicated to the ethnology and documentation of contemporary and traditional dance from Africa and the African diaspora.

Page earned his bachelor's from the School of Dance at the University of the Arts and his MFA from School of the Arts at Columbia University.

On campus, Vetesi has served as an executive board member of the tour guide program and as a campus delegate coordinator and student greeter for the Office of Admissions. For the last three years, she has worked as an EMT with Muhlenberg College Emergency Medical Services and was recently named a top responder.

She also completed an internship with St. Luke's University Health Network, where she observed physicians and physician assistants in clinical settings.

Following graduation, Vetesi will spend a year working as a medical assistant. She has applied to dual degree programs to pursue a master's degree in physician assistant studies and public health. She is excited to begin a career in public health, a decision she says was particularly inspired by HIV & AIDS in the Lehigh Valley, a course taken with Rachel Hamelers, teaching & learning librarian at Muhlenberg's Trexler Library.

Rajan is a member of the Alpha Epsilon Delta prehealth honor society. She was named recip-

ient of the William A. Flamish Memorial Award in Neuroscience, granted to a student who exceeds faculty expectations and embodies the ideals of fostering creativity, critical reasoning and proficient skill in advancing knowledge in neuroscience, and the Resident Advisor of the Year Award for her leadership within the College residence hall community.

Rajan served as Prosser Hall director and completed appointments as a residence advisor—an experience she believes aligned with the welcoming, supportive atmosphere she values most from her time at Muhlenberg. She was station manager for 91.7 WMUH—where she launched Radio Riff-Off, a student-led music competition—and hosted Continental Drift, a weekly multilingual show that, in 2020, included interviews with Muhlenberg community members about how their lives had changed due to the pandemic and Black Lives Matter movement. She was a writing tutor in the College's Writing Center, a Student Government Association representative on the ad hoc finance committee and vice president of the Top Naach Dance Club. Rajan was also a member of the College's COVID-19 education team.

In addition to conducting research in the laboratory of Matthieu de Wit, assistant professor of neuroscience, Rajan completed an observation at St. Luke's University Hospital Network, where she shadowed physicians across multiple departments in the campus network. She was a tour guide on campus and contributed to the Muhlenberg Weekly, Muses and the Muhlenberg Academic Review, where she also served as a contributing editor. Rajan wrote a young adult fantasy novel and will pursue publishing in the future.

Following graduation, Rajan will complete an internship with BookEnds Literary Agency, which aims to make literature more inclusive by assisting LGBTQ, BIPOC and other marginalized creators publish and promote works to the public. She will also begin work with City Year in Philadelphia. Following those experiences, Rajan will consider a career in medicine, with a particular focus on service to high-need communities.

As part of her academic capstone project, Peralta partnered with Lehigh and Northampton Counties' Financial Literacy Center, an organization dedicated to improving financial literacy in the Lehigh Valley. She has found it particularly empowering to work with single parents, veterans emerging from military service and community members who have traditionally been underserved by financial institutions. She hopes to continue financial literacy advocacy following graduation—what she calls helping people become financially awake—and she has begun researching the process to found and launch a nonprofit organization.

Peralta currently provides executive administrative support to the president of RETTEW Associates, Inc., a local engineering firm. She is also the owner of House of J Properties, a real estate company managing apartments in the Lehigh Valley.

She has volunteered with the Old Allentown Preservation Association for the past five years and currently serves as a board member. The group works to preserve Allentown's historic architecture and manages street cleanups and other betterment projects, including the planting of new trees, within the borders of Allentown's Historic District.

Peralta thanks the many faculty and staff of Muhlenberg who have served as educators and mentors and calls her family, which includes a husband and two daughters, her rock during her College journey.
